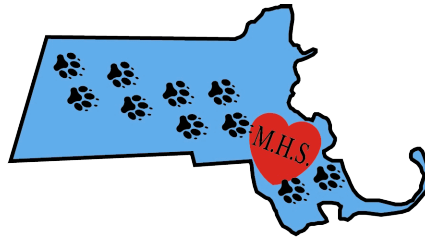

- * Volunteers for Foster Care Homes (for dogs, cats and other animals)
- * Fundraising Ideas (open to any and all ideas)
- * Grant Writers
- * Reliable person to transport animals when needed to the Veterinary Hospital and back.
- * Someone to handle MHS Newsletter - label and mail the print version via U.S. Postal Service, and handle the MHS Online Newsletter.
- * Feral Cat TNR Trappers (Trap-Neuter-Release) - experienced or willing to teach other Volunteers.
- * Adoption Application Telephone Interviewer – pre-screening for the adoption of cats or dogs.
- * Clean cat cages, feed, change water & litter boxes, and exercise cats.
- * Clean dog runs, feed and give fresh water, and exercise and walk dogs. Supervise the dogs while they are outside in the yard playing/exercising.
- * Do laundry, blankets, towels, etc..
- * Someone to mow the lawn in the Summer and shovel snow in the Winter.
- * Keep inventory / supply of dog dry/wet food, and cat dry/wet food, & cat litter.
- * Clean the yard, pick up papers and other debris. Pick up after the dogs in the yard.
